We continue working very hard to give our future visitors the best attention, in what will be our second Gathering in our country.



We have already confirmed the participation, in addition to Uruguay, of The Brothers Scouts of Chile, Curaçao, Spain, The Netherlands and Italy.

We have also received consultations from Argentina, Brazil, Colombia, Mexico, Panama, Paraguay, Peru, Suriname and Venezuela.

We remind you that registration to the Gathering must take place before September 1, 2018.

The cost is USD 320 per person on a Five-persons basis, USD 420 per person on a Double basis and USD

520 on an Individual basis, including three nights of accommodation: on November 1, 2 and 3, 2018, twelve meals (3 breakfasts, 3 lunches, 3 snacks and 3 dinners), transportation, work



Knowing the Salinas Beach Resort



The emblematic arch on the Interbalnearia Road welcomes you to one of the most traditional beach resorts on the Costa de Oro (Gold Coast).

Salinas boasts the perfect combination between urban infrastructure and nature, with very good services (that serve all its area of influence) and a beautiful landscape of wide beaches. The beach resort houses an important permanent population that has grown in the recent years, but maintains its familiar and serene atmosphere even in the busy months of summer.

The beach of Salinas, with calm waters, is ideal for the enjoyment of children. The strip of sand is wide and typical beach sports are usually played.

Julieta Avenue, with its abundant shops, is one of the classic walks of the beach resort. The sunsets on the boulevard (Rambla), drinking mate, are also part of the Salinas's identity. At night, there are entertainment options for teenagers and places to go out to dinner. The **Albatros club** is the main social center of the town, with activities throughout the year.

- * Each delegation should include in its protocol 2 (two) National Flags of 1.50 x 1.00 mt
- ** For the Scout Campfire, each delegation must develop a typical representation of their country (dance, song, performance), with a maximum time of 10 minutes for each one.
- *** Bus lines that arrive from Montevideo (Terminal Baltasar Brum, calle Rio Branco): RAINCOOP (222, destination Parque del Plata);

CUTCSA (C1, C2 destination Salinas; C3, C4 destination Parque del Plata; C5 destination Atlántida) COPSA (761, (phone number 1975) that goes to the east through the Interbalnearia Road, stops at the Arco de Salinas. There Julieta Avenue starts, the main street of the city that culminates in the Obelisk on the Rambla, to 700 meters of the Venue of the Gathering.
