- 4 –Send a representative photo for each project.
- 5 –Your page/pages will be sent to you for approbation before printing.
- 6 – Contacts will be with the IS or with someone that the NP will appoint or the CB Group Leaders.

The description of the projects can be sent in word, the photos and the logo only in JPG as joint piece not included in the text of the message.
