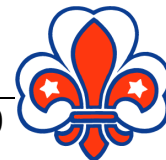
To: National Scout and Guide Fellowship (NSGF)

Two proposals for hosting the 29<sup>th</sup> ISGF World Conference in 2020 have been received within the deadline.

We received applications from:

1. **Ghana** Scout and Guide Fellowship;
2. Amistad Internacional Scout y Guia – España, the National Scout and Guide Fellowship of **Spain**.

Each candidate will have the opportunity to introduce his bid to the World Conference on 11<sup>th</sup> October 2017, focusing on the venue facilities, the costs and the features of their candidatures. However, in the meantime, you will find a first insight of the national particularities of the country candidates (information provided by the candidates themselves).

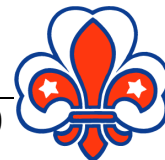
The social program will provides all delegates with the full flavour of the celebrated Ghanaian rich culture – both traditional and modern, visiting of key tourism attractions.
