Dear members,

The 29<sup>th</sup> virtual ISGF World Conference is at our doorstep and will take place only on two days

**Saturday 26 February and Sunday 27 February 2022**

**12:00 – 13:30 Brussels time (UTC+1)**

Because of the two short time slots of only 90 minutes per day we will only handle the most important business part. We are working together with a specialized company in Brussels who has the facilities and the know-how to hold an interactive virtual event.

Only the chairman with the vice-chairman of the Conference and the Secretary General will be on the stage. The interpreters English and French, the two tellers, resolution committee and two members of the World Conference team will be in another room where they will guide and follow the conference. No online observers are allowed.

As we have members worldwide we have the time slot that is most convenient for all regions. The virtual Conference will be recorded and can be accessed for everyone via our website after the Conference.

Each National Scout and Guide Fellowship and the Central Branch have the right to be represented at meetings of the World Conference by only **one delegate** with voting rights. Prior to the start of the Conference the Central Branch co-ordinator will coordinate the election out of the Central Branch members except those who are candidate to become a NSGF. You are required to introduce the DELEGATE of your NSGF to the forthcoming on-line ISGF World Conference by filling-in and sending back this form to the ISGF World Bureau, before **15th January 2022**

A National Scout and Guide Fellowship voting by proxy on behalf of another National Scout and Guide Fellowship has the duty to find out as far as possible how the latter Fellowship would have voted on each item submitted to a vote and vote accordingly. It is envisaged that proxy votes will only be required for countries where there is a poor internet connection and the country holding the proxy will register a second delegate who will hold the proxy.

At the beginning of the Conference the procedure of voting will be explained. At the start of the virtual Conference there will be a test round to get you acquainted with the voting system.

Enclosed you will find special Rules of Procedure adapted to this online World Conference. Please read them carefully and if you have questions or comments send them to World Bureau before **15th January 2022**.

On 17 May 2021 the NSGFs received circular 08 "Proposals for Amendments to the ISGF Constitution and Bye-Laws". It is still possible to send your question and/or comments to World Bureau before **January 15, 2022**.
