Conditions to visit Spain



- **Valid Passport or ID card:**

The document must be valid up to three months after the expected date of departure from Spain and have been issued within the previous ten years. Citizens of any State of the European Union, Switzerland, Norway, Iceland and Liechtenstein only need the current National Identity Document. The United Kingdom and Ireland do not belong to the Schengen area and require a passport.

- **Valid visas:**

Visas are necessary for the citizens of the countries included in the list of countries sometimes with the visa requirement for the crossing of the external borders, which can be consulted on the website of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Spain: <http://www.exteriores.gob.es>

- **Invitations to attend the Conference:**

This document must be requested directly to visa@madrid2020.aisg.es

- **Medical insurance, return ticket and demonstrate sufficient financial resources:**

The minimum amount to be credited is 90 euros per person per day, with a minimum of 810 euros.

How are the Spanish Timetables?

The life in the city starts around 9 a.m. for lunch time a bit later than in other countries, between 1:30 p.m. and 3 p.m., and for dinner is usually around 9:00 p.m.

What kind of clothes should I wear?

Alcalá de Henares

Only few kilometers from Madrid is Alcalá de Henares. Of Celtic origin, it was also a Roman city (Complutum) and Muslim. From the middle ages it housed castles and palaces for kings and nobles, many of which are still preserved.

The first meeting between Christopher Columbus and Queen Isabella and King Ferdinand was held in this city. In 1499 his university was founded, very important in the European Renaissance culture. But what is best known for being the hometown of the author of Don Quixote, Miguel de Cervantes. There, the Miguel de Cervantes Prize for Literature is awarded every year, the greatest recognition of the work of Spanish-language writers.

During the Conference, we will visit this important city named a World Heritage Site by UNESCO.
