AsPac SGF Region -

15th AsPac SGF Gathering – held in Colombo Sri Lanka from 5th to 9th September 2018 attended by 25 members from states of Bihar, Eastern, East Central Railways, Gujarat, Kerala, Maharashtra, Meghalaya, Rajasthan & Uttar Pradesh.

15th AsPac SGF Gathering venue was at Global Tower Hotels, Colombo & delegation led by our National President Hon. Just. Kalpesh S Jhaveri, along with official delegates National Secretary Mecci, International Secretary Seema Rathi and Joint Secretary Diana E. Kharshiing and 21 observers, hosted by Sri Lanka NSGF with theme 'Together with Friendship Fellowship and Fun'.

Gathering started on 5th September by Integration Session and host team informed participants about all three day program and agenda of gathering along with evening tea. After Integration Session Indian SGF delegation met & discussed various parts of Gathering & participation. Followed by welcome dinner hosted befittingly and with Sri Lankan traditional touch.

On 6th September opening ceremony started at 9 am, beginning with National Flags installed along with ISGF flag & National Anthem of Sri Lanka being played. Tapan Kumar Banerjee was Indian Flag bearer in ceremony. Welcome address by National President of SLNSGF Dhushyanthi Perera and opening remarks by Satish R.khanna, Chairman of AsPac committee followed by speeches by Chief Guest & special guest. Highlights of Gathering told by Mecci Secretary General of AsPac & vote of thanks by Kamalnath, Vice President of Sri Lanka NSGF.

With tea break Gathering began chaired by Janaprith Fernando & monitored by Aamal Ali. Satish R Khanna again briefed the Gathering about success for last 3 years, Mecci Secretary General of AsPac committee, presented the first triennial report of AsPac Region for 2015-2018 and audited accounts by Treasurer Mr. T. Gunasheelan. The AsPac SGF Constitution discussed & Gathering took lunch break.

The second part had all countries presented their triennial report, Indian SGF presented its report by a video clip Seema Rathi.

International evening with Bazar & cultural presentations held. India displayed its tradition by putting up best stall based on Indian festivals, Culture of India and Taste of India lead by Diana E. Kharshiing. A sum of Sri Lankan Rs.6000/ earned by the sale of articles, donated to Sri Lanka Scout Association in Galle on 9th September 2018.

In Cultural program Sri Lanka presented their traditional dance. Indian SGF delegates performed traditional 'Ghumar', which was enjoyed by all the members. Auction of articles organized by SL NSGF to support Special Children for fund raising, Satish R Khanna & Mecci from Indian SGF participated by contributing for the cause.

On 7th September all members met at 9 a.m. and discussed the 'Vision 2024', led by Aamal Ali from Maldives and also discussed on the constitution which was left from the previous day. After tea break new members of AsPac committee was announced and India disagreed with one of the critical issue, stayed away from the decision of the Gathering.

After lunch, closing ceremony of Gathering held at conference room before 2nd part of extended Gathering. Mecci led this ceremony; he recognized all host team and presented pins and certificate to various levels of members of AsPac foundation. Blessings by AsPac SGF Committee outgoing chair Satish R. Khanna and vote of thanks by Mecci.

In the evening, all the participants moved for PM House of Sri Lanka by Tuk-Tuk (Three Wheeler Auto) for campfire and enjoyed high tea and various Scouting / Guiding performances by Sri Lanka. Graceful performance given by India (Bollywood) item was hit among performances by other countries. .

On 8th morning, after breakfast Gathering moved from Global Towers Hotel by special buses provided by Sri Lankan Army with special security and for sightseeing of Colombo City. Warm welcome by local District officials & Scouts of Galle District of SLSA at Resort, followed by farewell dinner organised by Janaprith Fernando as a part of Gathering.

Farewell Dinner evening began by lighting of the lamp by Chief Guest followed by traditional dances. Opening remarks by President and welcome address by Janaprith Fernando were given. Inspirational speech by special Guest followed by recognition of guests / those who supported the Gathering by Mecci. All enjoyed dinner and dances with live songs.

National Level Updates

Governing Body Meet - Governing Body attended by 9 members met at the office of Ind. SGF, New Delhi on 21st September 2018 chaired by M M Rathi Vice President the first part at 11-30 hours & concluded by 15.30 hours. The second part continued at 18-00 hours chaired by Ramesh Kumar Legal Advisor. They discussed the agenda of 28th GA including report & the Accounts to be presented to the General Members for approval. They also discussed about role & responsibilities by key leaders during GA, annual updates & vision 2020 assessment in accordance with feedback by 13 State/ District / Guild SGF's. 60 years of Indian SGF & its celebrations also discussed, set of guidelines enlisted. Legal issues including SNS & Indian SGF image including working & supporting BS&G discussed.

Life / Donor Members Meet - Convened at 4.00 pm a meeting of Life and Donor members held in the NHQ office attended by 21 members along with nine Governing Body members. The forum

of Life / Donor / NRI Guild / Ambassador Guild will be function under Governing Body, this is to manage direct members of Indian SGF NHQ in various levels & with brief welcomed by Mecci and the purpose of the meeting was placed before the forum. It proseed & decided by the forum that Ramesh Kumar, will be the Chairman & Amit Aggarwal will be Convener of the forum. As agreed by all senior most Life Member from UP Adhesh Saxena from Kannauj appreciated the move & being part of Forum, expressed his happiness. Membership updates are on at all levels, efforts were taken to streamline & communicate with all to keep the forum active & can also act as one of the resource to Indian SGF.

Ideas floated to keep forum active under chair & convener, including look into avenues of partnership in keeping with Vision 2020 for projects to be involved in. The meeting ended with a cup of tea, sweets and singing of songs, sharing of lighter veins experiences.

28TH GENERAL ASSEMBLY held on 21 September 2018 in Lakshmi Mazumdar Bhavan facilitated by Bharat Scouts & Guides NHQ New Delhi. Registration began at 9.00 am and total of 109 members joined from 24 States including Indian Railway zones. .

The General Assembly commenced at 10.45 am, with opening remarks of Vishnu Agrawal National Coordinator, Chaired by Vice President M.M.Rathi. The Assembly honored by the presence of Bronze Wolf G Ranga Rao as Chief Guest and Guest of Honor V R Ghanathey for opening. With Scout Guide Prayer, Munira Mistry, Vice President paid tributes to departed souls including Kala Phadnis, Dr. S.A. Mehta, Sohanlal Telsra, Bhavarilal Toshniwal, Honsen Lyngdoh and W.Gasperly Marwein including those who were not named, left abode from the world of Scouting & Guiding family. Vijay Vani Chair of Southern Regional SGF Council prayed for the victims of Kerala Floods including partial Karnataka border and house stood in silence, observed for those gone home and Kerala Flood victims & families.

M.M.Rathi welcomed the members to the Assembly, organisation is about being a family which cared & shared each other at all times by working together by providing health care, partnering with other like-minded organizations in setting up regular projects to compile with Fellowship objectives. He also mentioned the contributions made by different individuals / groups to Kerala Floods. He stressed to adopt projects for differently abled young people and stand with BS&G to serve society. Harbhajan Singh G. Ranga Rao presented Scarf and memento and to V R Ghanathey

by Mrs. Amelia Swer, Adviser Ind SGF. Attendance and recognition of all state delegation was done.

Pictorial Structure of the Indian SGF at all levels in accordance with constitution presented & briefed to GA. To keep track of Vision 2020 every one asked to follow the structure.

Followed by Annual Report 2017-2018 presentation by team of Governing Body Munira Mistry, Seema Rathi & Diana, the printing mistakes enlisted & success stories at all levels appreciated. GA approved the report & house took on records highest number of new units were registered / renewed during year.

M.M. Rathi, Vice President, Sampath Kothari, Treasurer and Dr. Deepak Patel, Jt. Secretary (Ops) presented the audited Accounts for the year 2016-2017 and Trial Balance for 2017 – 2018. Except one observation on technical correction, the accounts is approved & passed by GA. Further, with financial updates, details of Kerala Flood Relief contributions, AsPac SGF Foundation Launching & Fund Raising Dinner contributions cum memberships presented. Meghalaya BSG & Meghalaya SGF were recognized for becoming first Indian Groups to join AsPac SGF Foundation, Dr. Verghese President of Meghalaya SGF received the recognition and Pradeep Sharma Convener of Northern Regional Council also recognized for his efforts to support various activities of Indian SGF. The Triennial Report in video of Indian SGF presented during 15th AsPac SGF Gathering in Sri Lanka is shown to GA.

Discussion on Vision 2020 taken up for updates & feedback. Many States did not respond, some did not even take the time to read, some sent personal feedback without taking their councils / governing body in to confidence. The importance of Vision 2020 stressed; it shifted to second half of GA to discuss in presence of Legal Advisor.

Supporting Bharat Scouts & Guides – Acting Director Krishna Swamy of BS&G invited to be present in the deliberations. Ind SGF in some States were enticing Rovers/Rangers to join Ind SGF with certain promises and the house questioned on this raises a point. It is further observed that few SGF units are involved in youth program. In presence of Director, with brief discussions, the following points were re iterated.

1. Where there is no Ranger/Rover Units of the BS&G, the membership of Indian SGF is open to 21years and above. If any individual who has accepted adult leadership at the age of 18 years of age in BS&G as per rules & registered, as unit leader, he or she considered adult & allowed to join Indian SGF.
2. If Ranger/Rover Units are functional at local levels, the membership of Indian SGF is open to 25 years onwards.
3. Youth Program – No Indian SGF member or units allowed conducting or organizing activities, which fall in purview of APRO Part II & III. Instead they can extend support by providing resources including finances, materials, souvenirs, uniforms, or to work as Badge Examiners or Badge instructors with due permission of local BS&G district authorities.

4. Adult Training – Some of Indian SGF members are also holding honorable charges or warrants, they cannot hold or organize adult training's as per Rules or schemes in the banner of Indian SGF. They should follow the terms & conditions as per BS&G; work with local authorities of BS&G.

Krishna Swamy, is invited to share his thoughts on partnering with Ind SGF at State/District level. He reiterated that BSG wanted to work alongside, in partnership wherever necessary and that the interests were the same. He also pointed out to the age factor and whether there is any Scouting/Guiding in the area, and again, he suggested that where there is no Scouting/Guiding, the Ind SGF may approach the BSG with the information, but not to take any action on its behalf except in a supporting role. BSG accepted Dual Membership with mutual consent of individual or groups. He also thanked the Ind SGF for the supportive role they played at different levels. Patron Executive S.N. Sharma, felicitated Krishna Swamy with souvenir & thanked him for his presence.

Curtain Raiser: Presentation by hosts of various Annual Activities of Indian SGF were taken up for brief information to GA, in order to keep all informed about forthcoming events as well as get ready to be part of same.

1. 13th National Gathering, Lonvala Maharashtra, 12th – 14th April 2019 – On behalf of Maharashtra State SGF, State Organising Secretary & founder of Lonavla Guild SGF Santosh Talape briefed the GA about attractions, arrangements they are planning & promised complete cooperation with NHQ Indian SGF. The National Gathering will have some competitions for the participating states and visit to SANGAM Center of WAGGGS at Pune is also planned. – GA took break for lunch & reassembled in main auditorium.
2. 3rd Adventure for Adults and celebration of 100 years of Rovering, State Training Park of BS&G E Railway Madhupur, 11th to 15th December, 2018 - on behalf of E Rly State SGF Dipankar Dasgupta Secretary of Asansol District SGF gave a brief of logistics & campsite details. He also proposed outline of activities with budget.
3. 1st Indian Railway SGF Meet, Kharagpur/ Digha (WB) S E Railway, 23 & 24 Feb 2019 - On behalf of hosts South Eastern Railway State SGF Kalol Dey State Vice President gave a brief presentation. He updated the GA about arrangements made for accommodation & sightseeing planned in Digha.
4. Kumbh Mela Services, Allahabad (Praygaraj) UP, 15th Jan to 4th March 2019 – On behalf U P State SGF State Secretary Pradeep Sharma gave brief on Kumbh Mela & its importance. He said each State will be requested to depute volunteers to help Ind SGF stall at Allahabad for Lost and Found service center. Volunteers would have to pay towards food and lodging during the tenure of their service at the Mela, which will be nominal.

Vision 2020 – is taken up for further deliberation in presence Legal Advisor, the priorities of vision 2020 were recollected & achievements in accordance with feedback is briefed. In continuation, the following points discussed.

- 1) Feed Back on VISION 2020 – Received feedback from 13 units & after analyzing with NHQ records, following were the findings in short.
 - a) Membership – overall growth is as per fixed targets, failure is reaching out to new districts; only three states have crossed Districts SGF above 10.
 - b) Organisation – out of 32 States SGF we have, four failed to be in norms of age factor as per advisory & out of four 2 states are at the verge of collapsing, as no second line of defense (leadership to take over)
 - c) Management – only 12 States have Bank accounts, out of twelve only three are submitting audited accounts to NHQ. Annual GA's & Council Meets are regular almost in every state, two states have no state councils functioning & no annual GA's held.
 - d) Activities / projects – every state is doing their best, few are doing best projects & reporting has improved from last year.
 - e) Communication – except one state all are satisfied, reporting is good & two states failed even after regular reminders in sending reports.
 - f) Social Media – many units are using the SNS platform very well to improve image of Indian SGF and visibility has improved. Much of communication is simplified and concise, becoming task oriented communication rather personal. It is observed few individuals are going against Governance, which create conflicts with in.
 - g) Out of feedback received – it is found, the feedback is personal & not collective, even key office bearers of council were not consulted.
 - h) Resources – how to handle & manage resources, moving & immovable, finances also is another point raised.
- 2) By keeping above findings – legal advisor had interaction with GA along with NS Public Relation –
 - a) Legal Committee will issue guidelines on SNS usage & interest of Indian SGF will be protected.
 - b) Government of India guidelines / advisories issued in all aspects to nonprofit organizations will be taken in to account and Indian SGF will be governed by same.
 - c) Resources securities – Indian SGF will not take plunge in mutual funds' investments and measures will be taken to keep resources secured.

To sum up the communication should be collective & prevalent Law is to be followed by all regardless and that there is a law relating to non-profit organizations only.

Charters Presentations – monitored by Diana E. Kharshiing, Jt. Secretary (Admn), M.M. Rathi, Vice President, G. Ranga Rao and V R Ghanatheey presented charters to 25 new State's/ Districts / Guilds SGF. Followed by Ranga Rao blessings to the GA and a poem recited by DR. Hemant Mishra Donor Member.

The Life Time Achievement Award in Cub Section as resolved in Special GA Ahmedabad 2016 introduced in the name of Kkashayap Kaushik Pujara & both parents Savitaben Patel Pujara with Kaushikbhai Pujara were present.

The closing of 28th GA began with arrival of Chief Guest Chief Justice of Jammu & Kashmir Ms. Geeta Mittal and Guest of Honor, Chief National Commissioner of Bharat Scout and Guide, Dr. K.K. Khandelwal. Along with Shri Satyanarayan ji Sharma Patron Indian SGF & VP BS&G, Advisor of Indian SGF Ms. Amelia Swer and International Commissioner (S) of BS&G, Mr. J.C. Mohanty.

Munira Mistry, Vice-President welcomed the guests with brief background of 28th GA. Madhu Kalia VP welcomed Justice Heeta Mittal & Harbhajan Singh to S N Sharma with SGF Scarf.

Evening began with Annual Awards of Indian SGF for 2018 in following order: -

Dr.K.K.Khandelwal in his address, appreciated the work that Indian SGF is doing nationally and in AsPac Region. His golden words for evening are “Indian SGF is supplementary & complimentary partner of BS&G”. He cited the example of Eagle, to focus on task & move ahead with positive approach. On the occasion “Golden Pin” of Friends of APR – WAGGGS is pinned & team of key leaders honors special recognition by Indian SGF to Justice Geeta Mittal.

Sataynarayanji Sharma, Patron Indian SGF blessed the house with his closing remarks. He congratulated 28th GA & assured BS&G, Ind SGF will work together in the interest of Scouting / Guiding.
