CORK CITY AWAITS YOU!

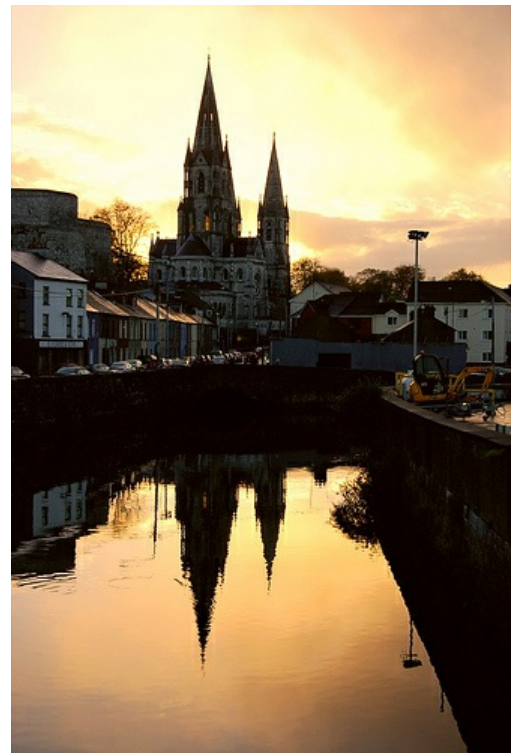
Cork City was founded by Saint Finbarr in the 7th Century.
