## How to come to Bremen

Bremen is a city in the north of Germany. The distance between Hamburg and Hannover is about 125 km.



### By train

Fast trains stop in Bremen Hbf (Central Station). Coming from Paris for example you will have one change in Köln—seven and a half hour



### By plane

The following airports are possible for arrival:

Bremen, Hamburg and Hanover.

The travel times are:

Hamburg Airport to Bremen Hbf (Central Station) - 90 minutes,  
change in Hamburg Hbf (Central Station)

Hannover Airport to Bremen Hbf (Central Station) - 100 minutes,  
change in Hannover Hbf (Central Station).

### Bremen



The distance between the airport and the main station is only 4 km.

There will be a transport for all participants of the conference on August 21 and 25.
