1st Sub- Project : ORPHANAGE "Enfant Haitien Mon Frère"

Building a fence on 1 acre land to protect the orchard.

- The orphanage, founded almost 50 years ago by the Guides Chaplain, Father Lespinasse dead during the earthquake- receives 48 children, 24 boys and 22 girls, from one to sixteen years old. The two older ones, handicapped will stay for life in the orphanage.
- Two years ago the children were moved to new premises in the surroundings of Port au Prince, capital of Haiti, were they live in small houses built by a Dutch NGO.
- The other piece of land has no fence and it's urgent because a friend agronomist planted several fruit trees so the products could be consumed at the orphanage. Many more cultures could develop the orchard in that land and so give a better feeding to the children.
- School material, Toys and Games are also needed....
- As school is starting, pencils, rubbers, pens, exercise-books and school bags are needed as well as games and toys.



Serves 120 children from 3 to 6 years old, divided in three classes of 40 pupils.


