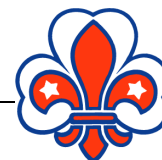

Any main and/or local activities?	
Cooperation and support to Scouting and Guiding in your country, any national / local activities?	
At national level no cooperation, but steps are being taken to do so. 2022 will see our involvement in the large national & international scout camp (40.000+ scouts & guides).	
Any involvement in community service?	
There is no national involvement as such in community work, but there may be minor, local activities such as visits to old people's homes and the like. A national project 'Reach Out' is in the making to help girls with sanitary items in order facilitate their attendance in school and improve equality to education. Funds for this come from activities organized by the individual guilds. Some guilds have projects in countries like Nepal (support to a school & local community in conjunction with already existing organisations). Local projects of knitting yarn to Gambia.	
Any international dimension in celebrating Fellowship Day, St Georges Day, Founders Day/World Thinking Day, Peace Light etc?	
Fellowship Day is mostly celebrated at district level in the form of meetings, debates, talks. Sct. George's day is celebrated locally and in very few instances with scouts	
What did you do to increase membership?	
The membership is aging, so to a large extent natural causes. In addition, many guilds reduce in number and therefore close down, and only a few members join a neighbouring guild.	



<p>We have recommendations to let small guilds survive. Some members stay on as members outside the local guild. We are taking contact with former, adult scouts to try to find a formula to maintain these generally younger persons and to get a kind of organized</p>
<p>Do you collect stamps for the ISGF Stamp Bank?</p>
<p>We do – the result from 2021 was considerably lower than previously, but still more than half of the guilds collect an 'weigh in' at National Assembly</p>
<p>Are you familiar with Twinning, are the Twinning contacts still active, do you wish to start Twinning but need assistance for that?</p>
<p>We are familiar with Twinning and have 26 registered twinning contracts. However, many of them have become void due to old age. Twinning is slowly dying out -no new agreements, and to our knowledge only 2 or 3 out of 26 registered are active and have regular contact The good news is that at least one such twinning relationship has lasted for more than 25 years and is still active.</p>
<p>Do your members participate in sub-regional / regional / world gatherings / conferences? If no, why not.</p>
<p>We mostly have a small delegation – and thankfully also first-time participants</p>
